

## GIFT AID DECLARATION

### Faith, Truth, and Hope

**If you are a taxpayer please complete this declaration to enable the Faith, Truth, And Hope to recover the tax you have paid.**

I want the Faith, Truth, And Hope to treat as Gift Aid Donations *all donations I have made since 6<sup>th</sup> April 2000 and all donations I make from the date of this declaration until otherwise notified.*

**You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year. (currently 28p for each £1 you give).**

**\* IMPORTANT Students and others who did not pay tax in earlier years should substitute for 6th April 2000 the 6th April at the beginning of the tax year in which they became taxpayers.** *If desired the above words in italics may be replaced by a different description of the gifts to which gift aid is to apply.*

### NOTES

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Faith, Truth, And Hope.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the Faith, Truth, And Hope reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Faith, Truth, And Hope. Or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR 65.
5. Please notify the Faith, Truth, And Hope if you change your name or address.
